Williams grantees of the second part witnesseth: That for and in consideration of the sum of one thousand dollars to the said John S. Russell and Sarah P. Russell, in hand paid by the said C. C. Williams, the wife aforesaid, it hereby acknowledged and declared the said John S. Russell and Sarah P. Russell, her children and wife, do make and sell to the said C. C. Williams a tract of land lying in Southampton County, known as the Daughtery tract, containing one hundred and forty one acres more or less and bounded as follows, to wit by the lands of Parker D. Story, East by the lands of Vick St. Bishop, South by the lands of Parker Story and West by the lands of Charles Pennington. And the said John S. Russell and Sarah P. Russell do declare unto C. C. Story, East by the lands of Vick St. Bishop.
