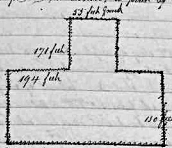


This Court made this 17th day of September 1775 between Joseph A. Pope and Son & Richard Smith of Washington County 75. Whereas that for and not consideration of Eighty Seven (87) Dollars the said Joseph A. Pope and his heirs forever all of his said Pope interest in a certain lot or parcel of land lying at Leesons Bluff 75. Containing land eight of one acre more or less and adjoining the lands of said Richard and Pope, J. J. Bonded Jan. 21. 1775 and 21. 1776. In said lot is laid out and designed by certain feet of 110 corners, a plot of which is herewith attached.



And the said Joseph A. Pope with allowed and affixed his title of said land to the said J. J. Bonded. Whereas the following signature and seal.

This Court made this 18th day of February 1775 between Salathiel Davis and Nicholas New Smith his wife of the one part and John Camp of the other part all of the State of Virginia, Whereas that for and not consideration of and for the said Salathiel Davis and Nicholas New Smith his wife do grant unto the said John Camp with general warranty all their right, title and interest in and certain tract of land known as the Little North tract containing by estimation and hundred, and fifty acre more or less bounded on the North by Black Creek bottom, East by Nicholas Hill Road, South by Grand River bottom and by the lands of John Camp.
