That in and to consideration of the sum of Twelve hundred dollars to be in hand paid, before the making and signing of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, they the said parties of the first part, do grant, bargain, sell and convey, and by these presents have granted, bargained, sold and conveyed unto the said W. C. Griffin Trustee of the second part, all that certain land, with and without, title and interest in and to that certain lot or piece of land lying in the town of Swanton Southampton County, containing six and seven or less acres bounded as follows to-wit: Commencing at the corner line of Lot No. 10 of Gordon and Bush's Survey thence south along said line 230 feet to the line of the said W. Williams, thence along the line of said Road each 196 feet to the street, along the back of said Road each 196 feet to the front separating the lot of Mrs. M. C. Corrie and C. C. Vaughan from the lot hereby conveyed, thence south along said Road 230 feet to David Torrey and thence along said Road 196 feet to the point of beginning. It being the said lot conveyed by David of Virginia and late from the said William and Henry C. Torrey to the said parties of the first part to which David Torrey is hereby added together with all appurtenances thereto and appurtenances belonging thereto.
