The Deed made this 29th day of April in the year 1775 between John Brithen Jr. and Co. his wife, John Coll and Co. his wife, and St. T. Coll and Co. his wife of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the first part, and D. J. Co. Daughtry of said County and State of the second part, touching and in consideration of the sum of Two hundred dollars to them in hand paid by the said party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, whereby unto the said D. J. Co. Daughtry, all of that certain lot of land lying in the village of Brimfield or its Irish side of second Avenue and bounded by a line beginning at the intersection of second Avenue and High Street, thence South westerly along High Street to third Avenue 250 feet second Eastwardly along third Avenue to a point on the same 205 feet from its intersection with High Street thence South westerly 210 feet along a parallel line to a point on second Avenue 205 feet South of its intersection with High Street, thence South westerly along second Avenue to High Street the point of beginning, containing a little less than one acre of land according to the Granting, but the said parties of the first part, convey on right unto the said party of the second part to enjoy the same or otherwise the public road leading out Brimfield as now located until said lands be located in some other direction.
