This Deed of long and full made this 1st day of November 1775. Between Richard St. Joyce and wife Elizabeth Joyner of the first part and Joshua Cole of the second part, both parties of the County of Southampton State of Virginia. Witnesseth: That for the consideration of one hundred and fifty five dollars and fifty cent. the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged. The parties of the first part will and by these presents do grant and convey, to the party of the second part, with general warranty, the following real estate, to him and his heirs forever. Which is to say: one tract or parcel of land lying and being in the County of Southampton Virginia containing forty acres - to the same more or less, and being a portion of the tract of land the parties of the first part purchased of Jas. St. John and wife Ruth bounded as follows: on the West by the County road (Baptist) on the East by the land of Jas. Peleg on the North by the land of Richard St. Joyce - on the South by the South Carolina State line. And the party of the first part, conveys to whomsoever and whomever the former hereby conveys against the claim or claims of any all persons whatsoever,

Without our brand and blemish any way and date first written.
