This Deed made the 14 day of October in the year 1775 between Patrick A. Bransel of the one part and John A. Brinsell of the other. Whereas that the said Patrick A. Bransel did give and sell unto said John A. Brinsell the following property: All of his crop of corn, peaches and fruit his lands to wether Samuel A. Brinsell in an ordinary amount of land, fields and woods 1776. I. A. Brinsell in the end of the said without day by deed. 1776. Henry K. Brinsell in the second of twenty five dollars due by deed. The provisions of the above documents are such that the said John A. Brinsell should pay the said debt to the said above named parties and in the event the contract shall be null and void of 2nd; the said John A. Brinsell (Deceased) then after giving proper notice forward to 1776 for each the above named crops. Each of the parties after the said named debts to the parties above named and the remainder of any thing more the said Patrick Bransel, after deducting expense of sale.

Articles of Agreement made and entered into this 1st day of May 1795 between
J. J. Jarnett of the City of Petersburg, Virginia, of the first part, and John S.
Henderson of the second part, in pursuance of the 13th section of the 1st Act of the
said date of 1793, vizt: That said J. J. Jarnett agreed, on his part, to furnish to the
said John S. Henderson's supplies to the amount of 200 pounds sterling five shillings
(£205) to enable the said John S. Henderson, to serve on him during the year ending
the seventh year, 1795, in the County of Southampton. In consideration of which
agreement to be made by the said J. J. Jarnett to the said J. S. Henderson, he did
heavily bind himself, his heirs, administrators and assigns, to assign to the said J. J.
Jarnett, all his crops of cotton made during the year, and do furthermore agree
and agreed, that this deed shall constitute a lien on the said crops &c. and other profits
of the said John S. Henderson until the entire indebtedness of said John S. Henderson
shall have been fully paid off and discharged. And the party of the second part
hereby waives the benefit of Sayre's Amendment as to this contract.
