This Bond of Debt made this day of Oct. 1775 between Quilbuck & Tye of the first
 part & A. James Denton of the second part unto the heirs or assigns of the first
 part: That in consideration of the hereunto named promise, the said Quilbuck &
 Tye do grant and convey with general warranty to the said David James Denton or assigns,
 the following property (to wit) the noted surplus stock now remained in a stock of Dutch made
 by the said Quilbuck & Tye to the said A. James or Denton, for the length of thirteen
 & Tye which said stock was taken in the year Eighteen hundred and twenty four,
 with his present crop of cotton, rice, indigo, peas, pecanutt and potatoes except four rods extra
 to which said 233 he which the said C. & Tye reserves to himself for the purpose of fowling of
 his hands this year for hunting his snipe, with any other article of property of any kind
 owned in the foregoing stock to said Denton for the length of said 13 & Tye and any property
 the said C. & Tye may hereafter acquire in the execution of the above said stock, all in such
 to wit the following debt and interest due by the said C. & Tye to, and owing money or currency
 to Benjamin Tye for about Five hundred and forty seven dollars, a shilling due Jas. J.
 Gordon for Five hundred and forty five dollars and two cents dated the 17th of October
 1775, a Bond due Thomas & Wyckoff for Five hundred and fifty eight dollars and fifty
 for both dated the 17th of October 1775, a debt due James or Thomas and Tye for about
 Five hundred dollars, a debt due Sanford, Henry for about thirty dollars, a debt due Dr.
 S. Gardner of New Haven and a debt due J. C. Bailey for twenty dollars and which is expressly agreed
 upon by this parties to this Bond that if a sale shall become necessary, he shall be first paid,
 after giving twenty days notice of same, it is further agreed upon by these parties to this Bond that
 in the event of a sale a distribution of the proceeds shall be made ratably of all the debt by
 the Denton, and all and any moneys coming to the hands of the said Denton, shall be paid over to all the debt herein set forth ratably and before any thing is paid over to the
 Denton & his children, he shall never to himself his heirs or assigns of five per Cent.
