Carter, the said William Dye and Eliza his wife, wife Longine, wife and Eliza, and by their presents do grant sell and convey unto the said J. A. Carter and his heirs and assigns forever all their interest in lands pieces or parcels of land lying in the County of Southampton State of Virginia, known as the Brinkley Johnson place and containing six and a half acre by survey made on the 2d, and bounded as follows: on the south and east by the lands of Denis Toole, and on the south by the Cypress Bridge and together with west and longline the aforesaid boundaries belonging thereto, to have and to hold the same forever, for and all circumstances.
