Corn to be sown and divided, the said portion having 1000 square Rods and bounded, Cutt ground and land, long, boggy and like for the said portion to be furnished by heirs and friends (&c.) of all Cutts made or said land to be paid as rent and in Abot Comodit. All necessary adwartments made to set for Cultivating and Sowing said Cutts, etc. nowe this remaining (1795) seal such charges and expenses shall be expensized.

Deed of Bargain and Sale made this 1st day of December A.D. 1795 between Jacobus Vining and Mary Ann Johnson his wife, Grantees of the first part, and Nathan Johnson, Grantor of the second part, all of Southampton, State of Va. and in Consideration of the sum of One hundred Dollars (\$100.) this day paid by said part of the second part, and the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged by said parties of first part, they saye said Nathan Johnson and Mary Ann his wife do grant and convey, longe and certaine unto the said Christian Johnson, all that tract or part of Land situated in Southampton Co. Containing 100 acres more or less and bounded as follows, viz: on North by the lands of Ruth & Ruth Lee, and Ruth & Will Pond, on West by land formerly belonging to Christian Johnson, on East by the land formerly belonging to Nathan Johnson, and on the last by the land of John and Sarah Johnson. The said Deed of Land being the same signed acknowledge by both Nathan Johnson and Mary Ann Johnson, and which he purchased of Isaac Cooper and son.
