was this day received and, together with the certificate thereon, admitted to record.

The Clerk of Court made twenty fourth day of December 1875, between Henry D. White and Rosa A.
White wife of the first party, No. 1, Republic Street, the second party. To the receipt of the third party,
Whitfield Clark Esq. in consideration of that plaintiff having been the claimant & the further
consideration of one dollar to him in hand paid by the said No. 1 Republic Street. He receipt &
thereof is hereby acknowledged. Did said Henry D. White and Rosa A. his wife as grantor and
Conor and the said No. 1 Republic Street, and certain tract of land situated in the County of
Southampton State of Virginia, bounded by the lands of E. L. Stiles, No. 6 Republic, No.
6 Republic and James & Edwards containing two hundred and fifty acres to the said
land or lot, to him and his heirs forever. In which however to secure the following bonds, even
though and due December 1st, County, fourties, Capital demand and interest first, for the
sum of one hundred dollars, while interest from date one dollar for twenty dollars, called security bond
at Repart day of December last, and interest first and also taxes monthly after date to
be paid in least sum of the State of Virginia, which debts are due by the said Henry
D. White to the said D. C. Morgan. It is stipulated and agreed upon by the parties to this
the instrument that no part of the tenement shall be sold or sold off the land, unless the sale of such
as may be applied to the payment of the principal named debt or partly used toward the
payment of the instrument of such bond, and it is further agreed upon by the parties to this instrument, that
one of the said Henry D. White shall fail to pay the aboves named debt and interest by the twenty
fourth day of December last, demanded and interest due, then the said D. C. Morgan or his
legal representatives shall be his or their discretion older the said Clerk to sell the said tract
of land for each, after giving ten days notice of the time and place of sale, pay all expenses
