This Deed made the 15th day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand eight
hundred and twenty six between Richard S. Morgan and Richard S. Morgan the wife of the
County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part and Daniel H. Clegg
of the other part. Whereas: that no consideration of the sum of twelve hundred dollars
the said Richard S. Morgan and Richard S. Morgan the wife do agree with general Assembly
& others parts the said Daniel H. Clegg his heirs and assigns forever the following and after
in this the 15th day of January first of the tract of land on which the said Morgan and wife did
of a lot to Clegg at the rate of £10 per acre of the said land or land near the older house
or land that said Clegg's house toward said P. L. Morgan's house. Thereof did a
church South thereof a lot of 150ft and measured back to the rear side thereof on the 20th and
along P. L. Morgan's line to Richard S. Parrott land thereon down said Parrott's line
nearly a half acre to the branch Community called the Custer branch. Thereof down
the said course of said Custer branch to the right or next said land from Robert
Whiting's shop to P. L. Morgan's house. Thereof down said path or next nearly to the
Commonwealth and out half of the said house referred to contain two hundred
and seven or eight acres and to hold said described land together with and singularly its
