lot of land lying in Smithfield Co. Virginia, containing forty five (45) acres more or less and
bounded by the lands of C. C. Royle, Companyville and Tom C. Eggers, it being all the lands
described in the said Joseph A. Applewhite's Deed or Deed of Record and bordering from Chapman's
to Royle's bridge. The above tract of land is covered with general vegetation.
