Rogers of the County of Washington, State of Virginia party of the second part, did say that party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of five hundred and ten lawful money of the United States, a true duly paid before the delivery hereof, have bargained and sold, and by these presents do grant and convey to the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns forever, all that certain parcel or parcel of land situate lying and being in the County of Washington and which is known as the "Potomac Place" containing 17.8 acres to be it the same day or 60, and joining the lands of George C. Hill, Charles Hill, N. P. Rogers and to the N. E. of the Congressional Square and all the town and appurtenances thereto belonging. And the said Wm. H. Hill doth covenant and guarantee and the said party of the second part full right and title to the above granted premises. And the said Wm. Hill, party of the first part, has released all his claim and sold the day and date above written.
