Knight has this day contracted to sell unto the said Charles Edwards the following real estate situated in the village of Southampton, County of Southampton to wit, all the real estate now owned by said Charles C. Knight in the said village of Southampton, consisting of his other house and lots double offices, kitchen, horse stalls, and all other buildings and appurtenances thereto belonging, for the sum of One hundred and fifty dollars. In consideration whereof, said Charles agreed to pay the said Charles Edwards one hundred and forty five dollars, for hundred and forty five dollars in cash, the balance in two equal annual installments, bonds of equal amounts, bearing interest four cents. And the said Charles having binds himself, his heirs and personal representatives, that when these two bonds are fully paid to release to the said Edwards, or his heirs or descendants warranty for the before described property, and to deliver unto the said Edwards the possession of the aforesaid property at once.
