He the said party or both, bounded by the bounds of D. A. Clegg, the trustee of D. A. Clegg's estate, the land of David Stevens and others, said being tract of land upon which Helland & Horne doth not own by law, D. A. Clegg, doth trust to receive the payment of a sum of money, amounting to £1000, due and owing by law, D. A. Clegg, to H. P. Goffe - and doth now and then bearing date with this deed. And it is further agreed by the parties hereto, that as rate shall be paid by virtue hereof, for twelve months from the date, furnished the interested said land is paid, summatly, over life of D. A. Clegg, 1776-77, longer indulgence is at the option of the said H. P. Goffe. It is further agreed, that should a suit be filed by the trustee of this deed, or his agent, or any other person related to the trustee, Goffe and Goffe or his agent, or any other person related to the trustee, shall be bound to pay all costs, damages and expenses incurred, and so much more, the trustee shall be entitled to five per centum compensation, as he may desire, and so much more, as the trustee shall be entitled to five per centum compensation, as he may desire. Clegg, of the third part, for the sum of one thousand eight hundred dollars, each having power of attorney to him or herself, or their several heirs, legatees and executors, and by their presents, etc., long since, with and contrary to the property of the second part, forever, all their common place or places of several of lands, houses and buildings in the County of Southampton, and where it may be and described as follows to wit: bounded North by the bounds of Pitts County, East by R. S. Morris and others lands by Leon, White and Pitts by Pitts and L. and containing fifty acres more or less, together with all trees, timber, stones, minerals, hereditaments, and appurtenances, and all the estate, title and interest, of the said party of the first part thereto, and the said party of the first part shall hereby convey, and that he will defend and defend the above granted premises, on the quiet and peaceful possession of the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns, forever.
