

Amherst County Va. a Public Officer, February 7<sup>th</sup> 1766  
 This Agreement being betw<sup>en</sup> Mr Richard H. Nelson and Edward Thomas of the one part  
 together with the Corporation of said County, against the other part  
 Dated the 10<sup>th</sup> of January 1766

The said Edward Thomas and John Smith this 7<sup>th</sup> day of February, in the year of our  
 said King's Majesty the eighth hundred and twenty six, being Richard Nelson and  
 Edward Thomas, of the one part and James M. Williams, grantee, of the other  
 part, for and in consideration of the sum of fifty dollars, in hand paid  
 to him, the said Nelson, by the said Williams, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged  
 and the said Nelson and Smith do by these presents and in consideration of the said sum  
 of fifty dollars, grant and convey unto the said James M. Williams, to him and his heirs  
 and assigns, with special warranty, the following divided tract or parcel of land, lying and  
 being in the County of Southampton, with the same land upon which the said Nelson  
 formerly resided, to wit: a certain tract or parcel of land, situated as aforesaid, containing  
 by estimation less or more or less, and bounded as follows, to wit: by the lands of James  
 Williams &c. and Samuel Willford, &c. being the same parcel or tract of land, conveyed  
 to said Nelson by Elizabeth Barber in the year 1757, by deed duly recorded in the Clerk's  
 Office of the County of Southampton on the 21<sup>st</sup> day of January 1760. reference to  
 which deed is hereby specially made. The said Nelson and Smith agree that they have  
 done so as to remember the said land and that the said grantee's title to the said land  
 is good.
