

John Dill made his 15th day of March 1774, Deed from Councill to Vaughan and Associates his wife of the County of Southampton, grantors, of the first part and Councill Davis grantee of the second part. Whereas, there are considerable parts of the land of Dill, now called and often called land by the said Councill Davis to the said Councill to Vaughan and Associates the aforesaid. They the said Councill to Vaughan and Associates his wife do grant and sell the said Councill Davis the following real property to wit: A certain tract or parcels of land containing fifteen and one half acres lying in the aforesaid County near South Swan Run, and bounded by the land of David Hollands Jr., Thomas Edwards and C. C. Vaughan, and beginning at a corner post standing in the center of small branch of Thomas Edwards land, thence along the said branch east to a tree at chain to a fence a corner post of David Hollands line thence N.E. 1/4 chain to a red oak a corner for his tract and C. C. Vaughan and said Councill's land above S. 12. In 14th chain to a small pond a corner for the walls in Thomas Edwards, about S. 16. & E. 9. 75 Chain thence S. 67. E. 1. 25 chain to fence at beginning. The above conveyance is with general warranty.
