 have for hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, being the said parties of the
 first part do grant bargain sell and convey unto the said party of the second part with
 express warranty, all of that certain tract or parcel of land situate and lying in the County
 of Southampton and State of Virginia containing by estimation seventy six acres of land more
 or less being the same tract of land conveyed by Estimation security six acres of land more
 or less Woodward of said bearing date on the 13th day of February 1776, and bounded as follows
 to wit: that the said tract by the lands of Richard Ogle on the north side by the lands of John
 Ogle on the south by the lands belonging to the Estate of James Commons on the East by the
 lands of James Hines, and on the West by the lands belonging to the Estate of William
 Ogle to have and to hold the above said tract of land to and for the said W. T. Cott & Wife
 his heirs and assigns forever. In Witness whereof I Woodward his heir and administrator
 do affix the payment of our bond for the sum of Three Hundred and five dollars
 certified by the said W. T. Woodward bearing date on the 13th day of February 1776
 and payable to the said W. T. Cott his heirs administrators or assigns with interest from
 date until the 17th day of February 1779.
