This Deed of Benjamin and Sarah Knapp this 25th day of August 1775, between George
L. Knapp and Sarah K. his wife of the first part, and D. Richard Quiller, for the benefit of St. G.
Knapp, that in consideration of the sum of One Dollar, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
and the said parties of the first part, have given, granted, sold and do by these presents do
grant bargain, sell and convey to the said D. Richard Quiller of the second part and his heirs forever
with general warranty, the following lot or parcel of land lying in Southampton County Virginia
to wit: A certain tract of land (3 1/2) acres or thereabouts and bounded as follows: on the South by
the County, and leading from Hester's Ridge to Rowland W. and thence from said road along
with a southern Christian to a pine tree which is a side line between the lands of said George
L. Knapp and said G. Knapp's tract, and said side line which is the Western boundary of
said parcel of land leads from said County road to Pine & Row and from said pine tree
due East to a small post oak, and from said post oak, in a Southern direction to the said County
road, the beginning.
