

Mr. D. made the 16th day of December in the year 1876 between Daniel Webster and Josephine Daupin of the one part and Parker D. Story, trustee of the other part, Haverfield, that
I said James F. Stalter and Samuel Ferguson did grant unto the said Parker the following property,
to wit, one acre of land named Columbus and his servitude for the term of ten years. In consideration
of a land gift of Alfred T. Edwards and W. H. Cleator of this sum of money leaving
date the 1st day of December 1875 and payable one half the 1st day of December 1876
and the other remainder the 1st of Decemr 1877. The condition of the above obligation is that
if the said James F. Stalter and Samuel Ferguson shall prominently pay to the said A. T.
Edwards and W. H. Cleator the whole sum of said land at the end of this term until to
such time as the title is to them also satisfied forerty for each to satisfy said
obligation as aforesaid. Witness the following signatures and seals.

Agreement between Simon Fletcher and C. A. Nichols. That C. A.
Nichols did grant unto Simon Fletcher the use of a bay mare Maggie, for the year
1876, in consideration of the sum of One Hundred and Twenty Five dollars, as consideration
of his land dated Dec. 1st 1876, with interest on that amount from date, with the
condition of all right and title to her above this land is fully discharged. Let it be
wholly understood that no right shall be conveyed with all of the land with interest
or rent. Furthermore that the said Simon is held firmly bound for any injury, death
or attack or damage from any cause whatever of the horse, if the full sum of the
land or failing to pay the same may be held for each and every damage that
he would incur of the Court or Circuit Court of the said Simon Fletcher. Furthermore,
no said land shall be fully paid by the 1st of December 1876.

Samuel Davis & fugitive, does hereby declare her intention to claim and take hereby
claim a homestead exemption by virtue of an Act of the City of Cincinnati
offered Dec. 31st 1874, in and to the following property real and personal, to wit,
for the benefit of herself and her children minor, Henry, Daunay, Mary, Sam Davis
Caroline, Dorcas, Susan, Daniel, Sally and such other children as may be born to
her and her husband Westcott. All of her husband's and herself's title is a joint
interest in and to certain tract of land lying in Southampton County containing 77.75
