Kinchard did bargain, grant and sell unto the said H. A. Pope his entire Interest (one eighth part) in his tract of land, well known as Phillips' Tract, near Springville, Texas, the above parcel of land. My Sny J. Kinchard now residing in St. Louis, to secure unto said Pope the payment of his note, due him by said Kinchard, and sets for money, viz. Dollars United States 174; the above for St. Louis alleged, dated February 3^d 1846. And should the said Kinchard fail to comply with the obligation specified in said note, on or before the 1st day of Feb. next, then the above promise is unperfected, after the return to sell said Interest between Concerned. But should said obligation be fulfilled then this deed shall remain and be of new effect. Witness my hand and seal above day and year 1846.
