

W^t D^r made this 17th day of February A.D. 1876, between H^r C^{ll}l and D^r Mary Ann C^{ll}l his wife, Comitors of the first part and D^r Mary Ann C^{ll}l, Deuter of the second part, of Southampton Co. 2^d Dist^r, that the said H^r C^{ll}l and Mary Ann his wife do grant and convey unto the said D^r Mary Ann C^{ll}l, Deuter, as aforesaid, the following tract of land to wit: First, the tract of land wherein the said H^r C^{ll}l now resides containing half acre and bounded and described as follows, "the tract by the C^{ll}l Point and road, or in other words, on the tract of Richard Hill and son, and on the south by the tract by lands of John C^{ll}l and son, and the tract of land known as "Doris old place". Second, and to wit all that portion of the Henry P. Daiggs' tract of land, not set off to Joseph P. Davis & J. S. Schell, situated to eastward, by estimation 100 acres more or less, and bounded on the east by the C^{ll}l Point road, on the south by C^{ll}l and Plaza, on the west by the Asuncion road and on the north by the lands of J.
