This Deed made this 26th day of February 1776 between Henry Williams of
the first part and Thomas J. Pease Jr. of the second part, one of Southwicksburg County
and State of Virginia. Whereas the said Henry K. Williams does grant and
convey with general demands unto the said Thomas J. Pease Jr. a certain piece of
land, lying in Southwicksburg, adjoining the lands of Collier & Williams, Mr.
Braydell, J. Pease and others containing three hundred eighty two acres half acres
by survey of C. Hill and being the same piece or parcel of land taken this day, Conveyed
to the said Henry K. Williams by Thomas J. Pease by deed recorded in the Southwicksburg
Clerk's office, and to which said grantee is hereby expressly made for a more particular
also disposes together with the rents and issues of the said piece or parcel of
land. The Consideration to the said J. Pease Jr. is however made in trust to secure
the payment of his eight following bonds, all of which are executed to the said
Thomas J. Pease by the said Henry K. Williams with a Contra-Indemnity as security
for the date 27th of February 1776, and one payable quarterly on the first day
of January in the years 1777, 1778, 1779, 1800, 1801, 1802 and 1803. The
first of the said eight bonds being for the sum of One hundred and twenty five
dollars. The second for One hundred and twenty five dollars. The third for One
hundred and twenty five dollars. The fourth for One hundred and twenty five
dollars. The fifth for One hundred and twenty five dollars. The sixth for One
hundred and twenty five dollars. The seventh for One hundred and twenty five
dollars, and the last and eighth bond due at the end of the said eight years
to be paid annually on the 27th day of January in each year. It is agreed
that it is made in the payment of any one of said eight bonds, or to intend
them, the said trustee Pease, upon being so required by the said Thomas J.
Pease or his legal representative, shall sell the property herein contained, in a
manner chosen as may be necessary, at public auction, and upon such time as
the said trustee Pease shall direct eight and seventeen days. The sale shall be such
for cash enough to pay the amount of sale, together with the entire amount of
any one or all of the eight bonds and interest that may not have been paid off
and after having paid off all the bonds and the interest that may have accrued
on them or on any of them. The said trustee Pease shall pay the value
of these bonds to any, up to the said Henry K. Williams or his legal
