Vaughan his wife of the first birth, Sam'l D<sup>r</sup> Darden, Trustee, of the second, both and our heirs of the third birth, Wethersfield, that in consideration of the sum of Five Dollars, the said Deon Vaughan the first born do grant and convey with general warranty to the said Sam'l D<sup>r</sup> Darden, Trustee as trustee the following and etc, to have a certain tract of land and improvements situated in Southampton County, Containing about one hundred and one acres more or less, it being the same in which said Deon Vaughan and his and adjoining the lands of lots 12 & 13 School House lots, the lands of Dr. D<sup>r</sup> Hill, Sam'l A. Hethersfield etc, and Henry Ferguson. In D<sup>r</sup> trust to receive the payment of a sum and interest due the said D<sup>r</sup> D<sup>r</sup>, by the said Deon Vaughan for the sum of three hundred and thirty Dollars, yearly from date with this instrument, and the last sum of a date, and it is mutually agreed upon by the parties to this deed, that if at any time during the payment of the said D<sup>r</sup> D<sup>r</sup> or his legal representatives, and if he or his legal representatives shall at any time believe a sale necessary or desirable, whereat he shall order the trustee regularly or by writing to sell the above described property for cash after giving thirty days of time and place of sale, when the trustee shall proceed to record the same after having all necessary expenses in the execution of this deed, including his and Commissioners of his last cost on the gross sale he shall pay the said D<sup>r</sup> D<sup>r</sup> or his legal representatives the aforesaid sum and interest and of any balance pay it over to the said Deon Vaughan or his legal representatives.
