The Oath of Garrison and date, from Mr. Hedgesmith and Jas. A. Rose, Hedgesmith, was this day recited and together with the Certificate there annexed, exhibited to record.

Date, 26 February 1776

This Deed of Sale made this 26<sup>th</sup> day of February 1776 between Edward Jenkins and Sophia A. Beale his wife of the first part, and Dr. D. Pender Davis of the second part, and Powells of the third part, Hedgesmith. That in Consideration of the sum of five dollars, the said parties of the first part chand and convey each to the other a general demesne to the said James D. Pender Davis as aforesaid, the following Real Estate of Hedgesmith, to wit, a certain tract of Land situated in Southampton County State of Virginia being at the said farm containing by estimation One Hundred acres to the side and of the back by the County Road to Backland and so high and bounded as follows, on the back by the County Road to Backland running thence nearly east to the W. M. McIntyre Land also to the W. M. McIntyre Land and on the south by Garrison Creek. Dr. Davis to pay the following land and interest, a tract granted by the said Edward Jenkins to the Dr. Dr. Jenkins died January the 3<sup>rd</sup> 1775 in sum one hundred and sixty six  $\frac{1}{2}$  Dollars and abrogated by the W. M. McIntyre to Dr. Dr. Jenkins and afterwards assigned by Dr. C. Beale to Powells of the third part interest at the rate of twelve per cent per annum and land has several improvements which having been valued by the original owner say £75. to be on the 7<sup>th</sup> day of February 1776 by Dr. Dr. Jenkins and it is agreed upon by the parties to this deed that the said Dr. Dr. Jenkins cause at any time after twelve months from the date of this Deed by giving notice in writing to the said Dr. Dr. Jenkins or his attorney where he or she may then be residing to sell or dispose where he or she may then be residing the said tract of land and the same to be sold at day time, ordered by the said Dr. Dr. Jenkins or his representatives and if of a talk at day time, ordered by the said Dr. Dr. Jenkins or his representatives the said Dr. Dr. Jenkins shall proceed to execute the same, paying out of the proceeds of such sale all expenses attending the same and about five £1. Commission five per cent
