H. J. Deane made this 9th day of March 1876 between H. J. Deane and John A. Vick, Esq. of one part and I. M. Lester, A. C. Stansell, J. W. Postle and J. M. Sticklen, Trustee and their Sureties in office of the second part, witnesseth. That in Consideration of the sum of one dollar, the said holder of the first part do grant and Convey, with general ownership of the second part, and this instrument is effect, the following real estate to wit: a certain tract of land, situated in Southampton County, Containing lots 200 & 201, lying on the south side of Somers Creek and bounded as follows: Commencing at the south end of the Bridge over Somers Creek, thence along the east end of the said Somers Creek to a black gum (corner), thence from black gum to Cypress, South Creek, thence from said Cypress back corner to the said Bridge Point, thence along said creek to the beginning of the south end of said bridge of said Creek, said being boundary of some marshy land described in deed recorded in Clerks Office of Southampton March 19th 1862, from H. M. Deane - referred to which is hereby made, no trust however for the use of the said Deane or his assigns. And it is agreed that so long as this land is used by the British Government for Church purposes then their title to said tract shall be held, but should it be used for other purposes then the title is to revert to the grantor or his heirs, and in such case the Deane are to have the right to remove any buildings upon said lands or such as they may erect there.
