This Deed made this 1st day of March in the year 1876, between John Codd and Martha his wife of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the first party and Richard Codd of said County and State of the second party, Whereas! That for and in consideration of the sum of One thousand dollars to them in hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged they the said parties of the first party do grant, bargain, sell and convey with general warranty unto the said party of the second party, that certain tract or parcels of land lying in the County and State aforesaid, about two rods from the Head of Drawback in a southerly direction, and bounded by a line beginning at a black pine standing in the rear of the Cedar swamp, and a corner tree from J. D. Codd, thence down said swamp in a southerly direction along a line of marked trees to a black pine a corner tree for the Cedar land and John Codd's house East end, along a line of marked trees which defines the line between the said lands one for each, to a black pine a corner tree for Richard Codd and the tract and a side line for Dr. Park, thence a little Northwest along Madison Codd's line to a white oak a corner tree for this tract and at R. Codd's thence Northwest along a line of marked trees to the black pine in the rear of the Cedar swamp the point of beginning containing by measurement One hundred and thirty five acres of land more or less. Holding the same tract of land formerly owned by the late Thomas Newcome as witness to the last person before mentioned.
