Pearce Jr. by deed of Longmeadow^t date Feb 1st 1833, and recorded in the Clerk's office of New Bedford Feb 2^d 1833, the said interest being described in the said deed of said Davis and wife as follows: "All right title and interest of every kind which they the said grantors have in and to the lands of which may formerly resip^t of — Dorset and late Henry Pease and who were a sister of the half bro^r of said Revd C^t Davis dec^d precepted, also all rights title and interest of such grants in the above lands now held by Mrs Maria C^t Pease wife of Nathaniel C^t Pease and late the widow of Oliver Pease dec^d which lands are situated in the County of New Bedford, likewise abutting against the lands of Dr. John Newell, Thomas Pearce, Jonathan Durfee, William Headen and others and also adjoins Coopers and Somers."
