inhabitants of the second tract whereof. Had in Consideration of the sum paid by said
trustee unto them the said Lester P. Edwards and Virginia. It has also been
Lester P. Edwards and Virginia. In his wife to grant with general warranty unto the
aforesaid Mr. Tolson H. Nichols L. Gray and Lester P. Edwards, and to their successors
to trustees of school District of Southampton the following tract or lot of land
in Southampton County of Southampton and bounded as follows North by Boundary and
Junction road. The first thereof West by said S. L. Coffey land. On the left to point in
said Coffey's and S. L. Coffey land. Then to S. L. Coffey's line. Clipped or Crossed by said
S. L. Coffey's line Edwards land about 10 feet to County road. Then West on
right and back corner of road and two first corners in said Edwards land containing
by estimation and over 200 feet or less. In said lot of land has a school house recently built
which is used. And the said land is conveyed by the grantor with the grantee with following
conditions or for the following purposes & with that it shall be used by the trustees of the
school or County to teach in operation a school for White children. And the said
trustee shall thereafter endeavor to accommodate to allow it to be used for school purposes
use for the instruction of White children, and in the event that such schoolhouse
is sold for a colored school. And the said land shall revert to the grantor or his
heirs. Provided however, that the trustees of said school District of County shall have
the right to remove the house or any other instruments which they may have put up
and let of land. Plus conditioned shall in no way interfere with any other use & which
the said trustee shall put said land, except the establishment of said colored school.
