Witnesseth: That the said Sister A. Gray and Elizabeth A. his wife, the grantors do  
grant and sell to the said D. B. Pease the trustee, and grantee, a certain tract or parcel of land  
known as the Pease tract, lying in the County of Belknap aforesaid, containing 125 acres  
and bounded as follows: & eastwards by the lands of Mr. C. Coffin and Captain S.  
Joyner, east by ad. L. Stannard's land, south by the bounds of Dr. D. H.  
Hobsonburg aforesaid, and west by the lands of George E. Morris &c. and lands to some  
land situated to the said Sister A. Gray to the amount of two hundred and  
1874 July 20. fifty dollars (\$50.00) to Rufus E. Bowles, leaving state thereof Decr 1<sup>st</sup> 1776, but it  
is hereby stipulated and agreed between the grantors & the said Rufus E. Bowles that  
Sister A. Gray and Elizabeth A. his wife, are to receive and quiet and female  
certified. possession of the above said tract of land, until payment of the sum of  
\$100.00, and after which time it shall be and payable on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of October, 1777  
or before if  
R. E. Bowles, settles upon the account of the said Sister A. Gray, shall after giving due  
Attest. notice by written instrument delivered to tell all places Boston &  
D. B. Pease and D. B. Pease, pay the amount due on the said land and the balance after paying  
of the tract, pay over to the said Sister A. Gray. At Wilmotfield the following  
summers and years.
