John D. Colley, his wife, of one part, D. J. Prince, Deuter, of second, hereinafter  
signed and considered of the sum of two thousand five dollars, the said party of the first  
part to grant and Convey with General warranty to the said D. J. Prince, Deuter or  
his heirs the following and which is a tract of land situated in the County of  
Goochland, containing twelve acres, square and more or less, bounded by the lands of  
John D. Colley, estate of W. W. Bonham, James Long and others, saving the land which  
which the said A. D. Colley now holds, & binds to receive the payment of a bond of one  
hundred thousand eight hundred and eleven (\$100.00) dollars, due  
date with this deed for one thousand eight hundred and eleven (\$100.00) dollars, due  
to said A. D. Colley to C. D. Griswold Jr. And it is agreed by the parties to this deed  
that as late shall take place by virtue hereof before April 1<sup>st</sup> 1877. It is further agreed  
that should this bond have to be recharged, it shall be upon record or otherwise when &  
the trustee, whom by days rates of time and place of date, and upon such terms as  
the said C. D. Griswold Jr. or his assignees may direct, and in such event the trustee  
shall be entitled to the annual compensation of five per cent on such debt.
