

 Monday the 17<sup>th</sup> day of March Anno Domini, one thousand eight hundred and twenty six.  
 Daniel C. Hill, Surveyor of this County, this day made a report specifying the water cut corners  
 of a certain tract of land, charged on the African Trade to Geo. J. Hillyer, sold in  
 December 1798, for the same fragments of land and purchase by James Thompson  
 according to the provisions of certain 19<sup>th</sup> Chapter 31 Acts of Virginia 1798, which it is ordered  
 to be recorded.

 S 20 E 20 ch. to a black gum a line to a small branch thence N 45 E 20 ch. to a black gum  
 thence S 20 E 20 ch. to a black gum in factory corner thence N 65 E 20 ch. thence  
 N 65 E 20 ch. to a pine a cor. for the tract of Sir Chas. Sir Pittman and Sir Gordon thence
