successors hereafter receiving it fully acknowledged, the said part of the first
part doth grant, bargain and sell unto Jasper, out of the 100th part
of the second tract (Strata) all of that certain tract of land lying in the
County and State aforesaid containing by estimation One Hundred and Two & 1/2
Acres and bounded as follows, viz. North west by the lands of Jas. Davis and his
heirs belonging to Black Rock Creek, to the south by the lands of Luther
Garrison, east by the tract of land of Jas. Garrison and wife and
west by the bush by the middle and boundary by the said John Jasper's house
and being the same tract of land conveyed by Daniel Paragon and his
wife Elizabeth Paragon to said Jasper by deed bearing date on the 1st day of April 1876 and
