of the like age, both Daugherty, that he and I, C. McEdward and Charlotte P. his
wife did Consideration of the sum of eight hundred and one dollars, do grant
with several covenants unto the said William White and his heirs and assigns from
him and him the following and estate, to wit: a certain parcel of land in said County

hundred and eighty eight acres to the same road on the south bounded east by
