

Witnessed by a Deed of Trust executed by S. Compton and wife on the 1st day of March 1875, reciting to C. C. Vaughan, Doctor, a certain lot of land lying in the Village of Drakesboro Southampton County, the said lot which the said Compton etc. last made for payment in said Deed mentioned, the said C. C. Vaughan in accordance with the provision of said deed did after due publication of time and place of sale, on the 1st day of March 1875, sell at public auction the aforesaid lot of land in two separate lots to the said holder and others at said sale the lot of said Doctor and James Davis Doctor are divided as the highest made for that portion of the said Doctor etc. designated herein as No. 3, Doctor's Street, which lot is in Consideration of the sum of Doctor Compton and Undersigned witness to him a honest man, the weight whereof is hereby acknowledged, to the said C. C. Vaughan Doctor, trustee, party of the first part, having this good old and County seat of Drakesboro and James Davis Doctor, trustee of the second part, make several warrants, the following portion of the said Compton lot to each, commencing at the intersection of Melville's Creek and East Street, thence westerly along said Street to the 1st fall by the said C. C. Vaughan trustee, to Hillyer Cutshaw, thence southerly along the said Hillyer Cutshaw lot 53 1/2 feet to the South end corner of the same thence easterly along the line of the said Cutshaw lot 53 1/2 feet to Dr. R. Cutshaw etc., thence southerly along the line of the said Dr. R. Cutshaw lot to Charles J. Lee his son, thence northerly along the line of his said Son's lot to the northeast and southeast corner and thence easterly along the line of his said Son's lot and back to Drakesboro's Creek, thence northerly by along Drakesboro Creek to Park Avenue, the point of beginning, containing by estimation a little more than three parcels of one acre of land.
