This Deed made the 2^d day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand eight
 hundred and twenty six, between Benjamin J. Copeland and Lucy Thomas his wife of the first
 part, and Ephraim Russell of the second part, all of the County of Southampton and State
 of Virginia, Witnesseth that in and to consideration of the sum of one hundred and twenty five
 dollars, the said Benjamin J. Copeland and Lucy Thomas his wife, do grant, sell, convey, alienate,
 with the said Ephraim Russell and to his heirs and assigns forever the following real estate,
 to wit: All that tract or parcel of land or estate the said Ephraim Russell now resides on
 as follows: Commencing in Depts Plowrie line on the Slave Creek, thence down the western
 corner of said Slave Creek runing a white corner to Andrew and well fork, on a further
 report thence along the western corner of said fork for the distance, nearly due West to Mrs
 Susanna Whistley's line, thence down said Whistley's line of marked trees nearly due West to
 Depts Plowrie line, thence down said Plowrie line of marked trees nearly due East to the
 Commonwealth, and said to be bounded by exact survey and hundred, and better more or
 less the same more or less, do here and to hold said described land together with all and
 singular the appurtenances belonging to the same, and the said Benjamin J. Copeland
 doth hereby give his right to convey the said land to the said Ephraim Russell, and
 that the said grantee shall have quiet possession of the said land, that he has now so
 and to be in possession the said land, and that he doth hereby make further appearance of the
