

To the Hon. Judge of the County Court,

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of Southampton County, Virginia.

After request of Samuel H. Smith, I surveyed certain parcels of land situated in the said County, known as a portion of Jacob Williamson's land, belonging to Mrs. Betty Smith and others (known as Smith's heirs of the said Jacob Williamson), including two separate acres, one of which is situated on the County road, from Jacob to Ben Smith and bounded as follows, Commencing said road, thence on the West along S. & G. Smith's line to dead oak on the branch of Smith's line, thence on north along said Smith's line, to Roger's road, thence on east along Roger and Smith's road, thence along Chappell's line to County road, thence on south along said road to Commencement, containing 215 A. 5 R. 24 L. more or less, which was by that road is kept 110 yd. conveyed by the said Mrs. Betty Smith with the said S. & G. Smith, as per recording instrument in the said Jacob Williamson's land. The other acre is situated in said County, and bounded as follows, Commencing at Confluence of Sharock and Smith's roads, thence up said Smith's road along S. & G. Smith's line to the ditch to the bridge in said County road from Ben to Ben Smith, thence continuing up said ditch on the East along Smith's line to the intersection with Crisp road, thence along said road and on old road, along

Crisp's line to Cor. near R. Road, continuing along Crisp road to Ben Smith's Cor., on Mrs. Taylor's line, thence on the north along said Taylor's line to Ben Smith's Cor., on Mrs. Miller's line to a large dead pine (Commence Cor.) on Sawyer's branch, along said Miller's line to Miller's oak Cor., thence along said line to main run of Sharock branch, thence down said branch along Commencement's line on West to Sharock bridge, along to Confluence of Sharock and Smith's roads, containing 213 A. 2 R. 20 L. more or less.

This area has been subdivided as follows, Commencing at the large dead pine (Commence Cor.) on Sawyer's branch, thence on the north along Smith's line, thence a main run of Sharock branch, thence up said run to Mrs. Miller's line Cor., thence along Mrs. Taylor's line to a large dead pine, containing 77 A. 2 R. 20 L. more or less, conveyed by deed made 25th Jan'y 1839, by James H. Shields, Grantor, to Benjamin Smith, Deedee, to S. & G. Smith. Continuing at said large dead pine, thence along Chappell's line to Western oak Cor. on Sawyer's branch, thence along said branch to the Confluence with Sharock branch, thence along said branch line hitherfor described, along

Crisp's line, Taylor's line and Ben's line to Commencement at the said large dead pine, containing 195 A. 2 R. 20 L. more or less, which is also divided by a line Commencing at said Western oak on Sawyer's branch, at S. & G. to Crisp road, the Northern area containing 34 A. 2 R. 20 L. more or less, conveyed by deed made 5th Nov. 1836, by Mrs. Betty Smith to S. & G. Smith, the Southern area known as Smith's tract, containing 101 A. 2 R. 20 L. more or less, conveyed by deed made 4th Oct. 1836, from Samuel H. Shields to S. & G. Smith. The remaining portion of the said land, known as Mrs. Betty Smith and others' (known as Smith's) containing 185 A. 2 R. 20 L. more or less, together with all the area known described remains charged to Mrs. Betty Smith and others (known as Smith's) sold for tax and purchased by said Samuel H. Smith.
