D. Rogers for the amount of One hundred and fifty dollars, toward which amount the said Caleb Cowrie shall not go, and the said John S. Prince having agreed on his part to furnish said advanced, that the said Caleb Cowrie and his part in consideration of the above premises also hereby grant a bond to the said C. D. Rogers at four cents interest or at sum of \$100.00 which may be made during the year 1870 upon the land and the cultivation of which the above amount of advanced has been or was intended to have been expended, to satisfy the above amount of One hundred and fifty dollars.

This bond is granted under an act of General Assembly of Virginia, approved April 25<sup>th</sup> 1870, intituled an act to secure advances for agricultural purposes.
