Articles of Agreement made and entered into on this 6th day of May 1876 between
James C. Hester of the County of Southampton State of Virginia of the one part, and John
Hollings of the same County, and others of the other part, Pursuant to the provisions of the
16th Article of the 1st Chapter of the Code of 1876, the said James C. Hester has furnished
to the said John Hollings the party of this second part \$200 pounds of which \$100 to
be paid him to carry out his farming operations on the lands of the said John Hollings
in the County of Southampton for the present year. In consideration of the said advance-
ment made by the said James C. Hester, the said party of the second part binds himself him
or his assigns to deliver to the said James C. Hester all his crops of Cotton made by him
during the year 1876 and hereby covenants and agrees that this instrument shall
constitute a lien on his crops of Cotton as above recited, until the said amount of \$200
pounds of Cotton shall have been paid off and discharged, and the said party of
the second part hereby assigns the benefit of the Homestead Act as to the obligation re-
