Article of Agreement made and entered into and this 6th day of May 1876 between James G. Pitts of the County of Guilford State of Virginia of the one part, and John Clemons of the same County and State of the other part, Person and the president of the 1st & 2nd Chapter of the City of Rock Hill said James G. Pitts has furnished to the said John Clemons the quantity of his second crop for 100 pounds of cotton to be paid him by the said John Clemons at the County of Guilford for the present year. In consideration of the said advance made by the said David C. Peters, the said James G. Pitts shall have his 100 lbs. of cotton or otherwise to the said David C. Peters all his crop of cotton made by him during the year 1876 and hereby covenants and agrees that this instrument shall constitute a lien on his crop of cotton as above stated, until the said amount of 300 lbs. of cotton shall have been paid off and discharged, and the said party of the second herein freely waives the benefit of the Homestead Act as to the property so charged. Johnson debt granted and held such the said Alfred J. Stephenston now over of lands to the same more or less being a tract of the John Johnson tract and bounded by a new line commencing at a point on the North border and running North to a black gum in the long branch, thence down and back to a point at A.
