A. Hoyle, Executor, to him and his heirs forever, the following personal property, in Shorthampton Co. Vt. his certain Corps of Cattle, Cows and calves, which he may make upon the land he now has under cultivation, and to him and his heirs the fragment of a load of new date seeds, his dead son and his hundred and fifty dollars in debt and did the said R. A. Bay of the party of the first part, and it is agreed by the parties to this deed, should a sale take place under this deed, it shall be after day notice of the time and place, and upon such terms as the said R. A. Bay, may propose, and in such and under the Deed shall be entitled to a Commission of five per cent on the said sale.
