 no representative shall at any time desire a sale necessary or desirable, then shall either
 the aforesaid Doctor or by writing to tell the aforesaid property for cash or on
 such term as they may choose, after giving thirty days notice of the kind and place of sale
 then the Doctor shall proceed to realize the land and after paying all necessary expenses
 in the execution of this deed, including his own compensation of five per cent on the gross sum
