^(S) Recd of David French recd his 10th day of May 1826, Admitted Bragg Edwards the
greater of the first feed, and Walter Penn the Dealer of the second feed, Pittsburgh;
that fed and in Consideration of the dollar per hand paid to the party of the first feed,
the weight of which is truly acknowledged, the party of the first feed do grant and
convey unto the said Walter Penn the Dealer of the second feed, the following property
to wit: one black horse, and all the rights of every description growing and to be planted, and
gained by the said Bragg Edwards upon the farm or estate he now resides, during the year
1826. The tract bounded to a river, a mile east of the N. W. Head of West hundred and twenty as
square dollars, and on demand at 5% interest per cent. It is further agreed that if the said
Bragg Edwards shall fail or die before the 1st day of November 1826, to pay the said estate
that the Deuter shall his privilege after ten days notice at these publick places in such
County still all the property herein enumerated for each and each of the persons pay each debt
owed and costs and damages of such persons pay over to the said Bragg Edwards

his mother Martha Pyle of the first feed, Dr. J. Davis Dealer of the second feed
and Dr. J. Davis Dealer and Myself, Steamer, Schenck & Davis, Pittsburgh, that
Graham D. Tracy, Dr. Bradley and Deuter & Deuter of the third feed, Pittsburgh, that
for consideration of the sum of five dollars, the said Deuter of the first feed do grant
and convey with general warranty to the said Dr. J. Davis Dealer, as aforesaid, the
following personal and chattelled estate, to wit: all their present growing crops of any
kind made by them and for them by their tenants and rented this instant year say
Crop of Brandy, Cider, Cotted, Corn, fodder, pasture feed and pasture. Also the
of hogs, masts, cattle, hogs and sheep and the future increase of all of said stock
and all other articles of every kind not heretofore enumerated by each party of the
first feed, to said Dr. J. Davis, a Deuty for the benefit of R. P. Pyle, which
Deuty was made in this year 1826, all of said property to be held in trust to serve
the purpose of the following clause and interest due by either the said Dr. J. Davis
or his mother Martha Pyle and to be paid at follows. First to pay Dr. J. Davis
Larion & Myrick, Steamer, Schenck & Davis jointly for one half being the
