Owing to my present circumstances I have a debt of one hundred dollars which amount they have advanced me C. D. Pepe since Oct. 1st and debt due James & Brother by bond for sterlity for ten dollars, the said cash etc to be paid in full or presented at the court may be paid and it is agreed and settled by the parties to this deed that any portion of the cash which is made by the said C. D. Pepe his tenants and master, which he sets out to C. D. Pepe may do with the same where he same to Jas. D. Pease and Jas. D. Pease, who shall have the same set off, collect the same and apply the same to the payment of the debt herein named as directed. The parties shall do for which he will be free of charge and it is further agreed upon by the parties to this Deed, that at any time after the maturity of all the aforesaid debts, any one of the foregoing shall have the right to order the Decease either verbally or in writing, to sell the estate of said property with the furniture for cash, who shall forward to us the sum after giving fifteen days notice of sale at three or more public places, and out of the sale first goes all expenses attending the same, including the cost of removal of fuel for sale of the goods sold, and the balance may be so directed in this deed.
