Schell Deutor his entire crop of Wheat and Corn, that he may produce the same in the year above said to the said (known as the Kest, place and belonging to the estate of Dr. C. D. Broome, do.). And to be a note of having been delivered that to John H. Corbitt and said note bearing date of this writing. And under my hand and seal the 5th day of May A. D. 1866.

This Deed made the 10th day of November in the year 1866, between James Daugherty of the State of Virginia, of the first part, and Dr. C. D. Griffin, Deutor, of said State of the second part, Witnesseth that for and in consideration of the sum of five dollars to him in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the said James Daugherty, party of the first part, did bargain, sell and convey with the said Dr. C. D. Griffin the following personal property, to wit: One horse, three dogs, one turkey, and a dog, four sets of harness, two barrels of corn and four barrels of flour, to have and to hold the aforesaid personal property to him the said Dr. C. D. Griffin, trustee, his heirs and assigns forever. And that to secure to John Williams the payment of three hundred dollars associated by the said James Daugherty and bearing date as follows: viz. One note for the sum of \$500⁰⁰ bearing date on the 10th day of November 1866 and payable to the said Williams on the first day of January 1867. One note for the sum of \$100⁰⁰ bearing date on the 10th day of November 1866 and payable to the said Williams on the 10th day of May 1867. And one note for the sum of \$500⁰⁰ bearing date on the 10th day of November 1866 and payable to the said Williams on the 10th day of November 1867. And that the said James Daugherty covenants that should he make default and fail to pay the above aforesaid notes or any of them, then the said Dr. C. D. Griffin, trustee, at the instance of the said Williams shall after due publication of time and place of sale sell to the highest bidder at public sale the property herein conveyed, and shall after deducting a Commission of five per cent and amount of sales and paying expenses of sale, apply the balance to the said James Daugherty.
