of the first part, and James A. Edwards of the other part, Whereas, as before
said Edward the said James A. Edwards is about to engage in the cultivation of the soil
and is desirous to obtain supplies during the year 1798 from the said James J.
Gordon for the amount of about one hundred and twenty five dollars and the
said Jas. J. Gordon having agreed on the part to furnish said supplies, Now
the said James A. Edwards on his part and in consideration of the above
provision with truly good will to the said Jas. J. Gordon on all the crops
which may be made during the year 1798 upon the lands of which the said
Edwards cultivates for the amount advanced to him this year which has been or
may be intended to have been repaid. The land is granted under an act
of the General Assembly of Virginia affirmed April 25th 1798 entitled an act
to secure advance for agricultural purposes
