In Trust, to secure the payment of the following bills and interest, to wit: one of ten dollars dated May 18th 1876 for fifty five dollars dated March 15th 1876 and due Jan. 1st 1876 and a for 2 and David and George for thirty five 75th 100 dollars dated May 18th 1876 and due Jan. 1st 1876 and it is expressly agreed upon by the parties to this deed, that if a sale become necessary, it shall be at the option of the parties of the third part or their representatives and if a sale shall be made, by auction it shall be either void or by writing, the Deedee and he shall after giving the day notice of the time and place of sale, sell said property for Cash and after paying all against attending this Debt, including his own Commission of five per cent on cash sale, pay the aforesaid and interest.
