Peto (Deutor) for Fifty Dollars due on 1st of July 1876 and bearing inter. from the date, also an open account for Thirty five Dollars (35⁰⁰). Also the said Saml J. Jones did agree with the said J. L. Parkman that some of the interest of said Crops shall be sold or disposed of without the consent and knowledge of the said J. L. Parkman, and it is further more agreed that should a sale be necessary under the debt it shall be after giving ten days notice of time and place and the Deutor shall be entitled to 5% there on said sale.
