The Agreement between Daniel J. Darden and Benjamin J. Darden, dated this day, amount and which the certificate thereto, amount, admitted to record.

Date, Southampton Co.

This Deed of South made this 6th day of May 1876, between Jno. K. Roperland, of the first part, and David Harris, Deedee of the second part, Witnesseth, that the said Roperland, that grants unto the said David Harris, Deedee with general warranty, the following property, to wit: All of said Roperland's Corps of land, situate, first, four rods and better which is marked on the plan as was last year, beginning at 92nd in the year 1876, he took to receive a land due Darden and Roperland for seventy five dollars dated the 1st day of May 1876, which interest until 1st Jan'y 1877, and it is hereby agreed by and between the parties that said Roperland that none of the said Corps are not to be removed off the land, or sold, without the consent of the said Darden and Roperland. The said Roperland, shall deliver to said Harris, all the land, as hereinbefore, as soon as possible, not less, he shall not and pay said debt, and if any left pay over to Roperland, if not enough the Deedee shall be enough of the other Corps to pay said debt, and said debt, Commission and pay over balance if any to said Roperland. And on the 15th day of June 1876, at said place, signed by the said Darden, the other subscribing witnesses thereto, and admitted to record.

Date, Southampton Co.

This Agreement made and entered into this 17th day of June 1876, between James H. Taylor, of the first part, and Baker & Baker (Seal) of the second part, both of the County of Southampton, and State of Virginia, Witnesseth, that whereas the said Baker & Baker has purchased to engage in the cultivation of the soil, and is desiring to obtain supplies during the present year (1876), from the said James H. Taylor, a credit from the said Baker & Baker, to carry on his crop, at the amount of the amounting One Hundred and Fifty dollars, which supplies the said Taylor, he has paid to provide him the said Baker, and the said Baker & Baker, he has paid and in consideration of the above advances, does hereby grant to said Taylor to the said James H. Taylor, on and the 1st day of July, 1876, the said Taylor, the said Baker & Baker, for the amount of the above advances, which has been, and being repaid, that said Taylor is granted credit on all of the present year (1876) of Virginia, approved April the 1st 1876, Witnesseth, the said Taylor, the said Baker & Baker, for the following signatures and seals, the day above written.
