

Effected, by virtue of the provisions of Chapter 58th of the Code of Virginia, A.D. 1870,
of the County Surveyor of Southampton County; did, on the 1st day of December 1873, being
Court-day, set at the Courthouse of said County, for payment of taxes thereon, a tract of
land according to the following measurement, viz:

The name of the land charged with taxes was, "Dance's Hollands".

The quantity of land charged was forty nine acres.

The legal description of the land was as follows: Black Water

The amount of taxes due was, ten dollars.

The amount of taxes due was,

The quantity of land sold was, forty nine acres.

The name of the purchaser was, Daniel Youngblood.

and the amount of purchase money was, two thousand dollars.

and although from the date of said sale no time has elapsed, and no one interested had
disputed the said land according to the 1st and 2^d sections of the aforesaid chapter,

and although the purchaser of the aforesaid land, has, in accordance with the 19th section
of the aforesaid chapter, had a report made by the surveyor of the aforesaid County to the

County Court, describing the mills and bounds of said lands, and the amount of the sum of
adjoining roads, and giving such further description as will more fully identify the same,

whereby to which said lands is hereby distinctly made.

I had, when the County Court of Southampton, of the Month of November, 1876, did, order the
said report to be recorded and the same has been so done. And whereas the said Daniel
Youngblood who became the purchaser of the aforesaid tract of land, has applied to me,

John Edwards, Clerk of the County Court of Southampton County, for a deed for the
said tract of land. I am therefore, John Edwards, Clerk of the County Court of Southampton,

by virtue of the foregoing, and the authority and power vested by Section 3d Chapter 51 Code
of Virginia, A.D. 1870, in myself grant and convey, with the usual warranty, to the said Daniel
Youngblood the tract of land bought by him of me, the County Surveyor as aforesaid, on

the day and year aforesaid, bounded as follows: To wit: Beginning in Bee Trap branch branch
of a small field, thence S 10° E to a black gum a few rods in south branch, thence N 65° E

to a black gum thence S 52° 26' E 14 ch. to a black gum and a trap branch, thence
N 63° E 63' 5 ch. thence S 6° E 53 ch. to a fence corner of this tract and the City & West
Bank, thence S 16° 32' E 6 ch. to a fence corner S 9° E 6 ch. 75 ch. to a fence thence S 52° E

6 ch. to a fence, thence S 5° E 5 15 ch. thence S 52° 65' 25 ch. thence S 6° E 41 15 ch. to
fence a thence S 5° E 8 ch. thence S 6° E 41 15 ch. to a fence corner of this tract and the
City & West Bank, thence S 52° 65' 25 ch. to a fence corner of a thence S 16° 32'

15 ch. thence S 6° E 5 15 ch. to a fence corner in Bee Trap branch branch, thence the rest of said
tract to the point of beginning, containing 49 acres, adjoining the lands of Daniel Youngblood
